Priority-1: Attaining the Bogor Goals

Excerpt from Para 4 of APEC Economic Leaders' Declaration of Common Resolve, Bogor, Indonesia, 15 November 1994:

4. As we approach the twenty-first century, APEC needs to reinforce economic cooperation in the Asia-Pacific region on the basis of equal partnership, shared responsibility, mutual respect, common interest, and common benefit, with the objective of APEC leading the way in:

- strengthening the open multilateral trading system
- enhancing trade and investment liberalization in the Asia-Pacific; and
- intensifying Asia-Pacific development cooperation

- Possible initiatives under Life Sciences Innovation Forum (LSIF)



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


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Priority 2 - Sustainable Growth with Equity: *SMEs Competitiveness*




Priority 2 - Sustainable Growth with Equity: *SME and Women – Joint Ministers Meeting*





Priority 2: Sustainable Growth with Equity Health




