2. Political System

A legal system affects flexibility of laws and regulations.

- common law : high flexibility
- civil law : low flexibility

A political system affects flexibility of regulators.

- parliamentary system : friendly relationships with legislative branch => more flexible bureaucracy
- presidential system : adversarial relationship with legislative branch => more rigid bureaucracy
