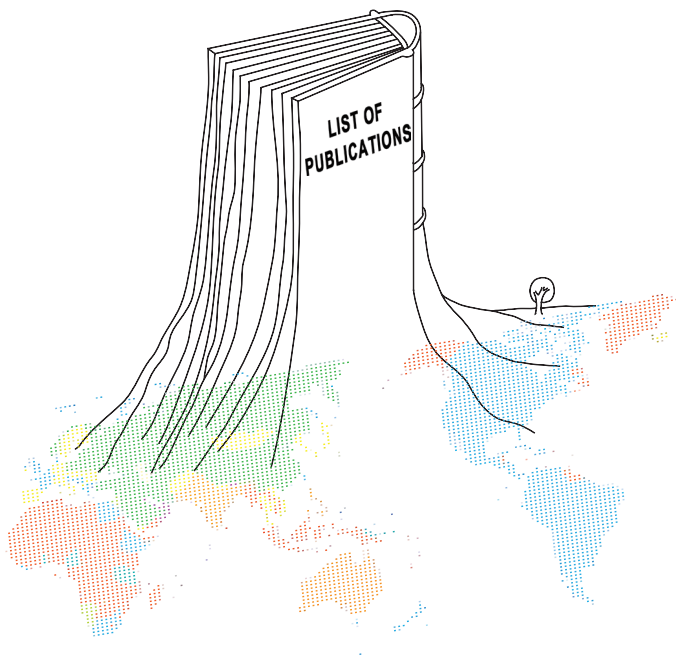
The journal is published every March, June, September and December of each year and submissions are accepted for review on an ongoing basis (no specific deadline).
